# **Elections & Campaigns**

- Hosted and co-hosted the most mobilizations for Democratic Party-endorsed candidates in Caucus history for 2021-2023 Democratic Party-endorsed candidates:
  - No on the 2021 Gubernatorial Recall
  - o Aisha Wahab for State Senate (SD-10)
  - o Jay Chen for Congress (CA-45) (weekly phonebanks with Grassroots Dems HQ)
  - o Dr. Asif Mahmood for Congress (CA-40)
  - o Diedre Thu-Ha Nguyen for Assembly (AD-72)
  - o Jocelyn Yow for Eastvale City Council
  - Wisconsin Democratic Party
  - o Georgia Senate Runoff for Sen. Warnock
- Hosted AAPI online rally with against the 2021 Gubernatorial Recall in July 2021 with Attorney General Rob Bonta
- Assisted the California Democratic Party in creating disaggregated AAPI lists to conduct outreach to AAPI voters to vote against the recall
- Engaged Caucus membership to translate anti-Recall voter education materials in five AAPI languages
- Redistricting: We increased awareness of plurality and majority AAPI districts post-2021 redistricting
- Hosted AAPI Caucus Open House at the beginning of the 2022 election cycle for AAPI candidates engaging with the Democratic Party
- Established relationships and promoted Party-endorsed campaigns that paid special attention to AAPI voters.
- Tracked statewide list of official Democratic Party-endorsed AAPI candidates for federal, state, and local offices
- Encouraged API candidates to seek official Democratic Party endorsements via the California Democratic Party (CDP) (federal and state elections) or County Democratic Parties (local and municipal elections)
- Encouraged Caucus members and activists to file and run for Democratic County Central Committee elections, Democratic State Central Committee elections
- Hosted AAPI voter registration training with Rising Organizers

- Created an online membership fee waiver form which was used as an example for other

- caucuses.
- Appointed standing committee co-chairs, interviewed members and initially brought on to committees to expand scope of work and to increase Caucus member participation.
- Sent letters of support for candidates seeking clemency.
- Created the APIs for Newsom project within the Caucus
- Increased lifetime and sustaining lifetime memberships of individuals, elected officials, and obtained new members
- Purchased new caucus domain
- Sent out timely newsletters with relevant information
- Maintained a precedent-breaking CDP Caucus balance of at least \$15,000
- Highest-ever CDP AAPI Caucus balance term ending at least \$17,000
